**GREEN BAY...** The Gard for Congress campaign has released its latest financial report, which shows a healthy fundraising lead in the race for the 8th Congressional District. The campaign is reporting \$882,285 of cash on hand, more than any other campaign in the race. In addition, an overwhelming majority---**95%**---of contributions raised are from Wisconsin. Nearly \$285,000 was raised this quarter, bringing the total raised since the start of the campaign to \$1,352,196. As proof of strong grassroots efforts, over 2,000 individuals from the district have contributed to the campaign so far.

"I am honored to have received such strong support from the people I hope to represent," said John Gard. "The recent numbers are a testament to the positive feedback we have received from residents so far on the campaign trail. Everywhere I go, people tell me they want lower taxes, affordable health care and good paying jobs. I will be a leader and a team builder who will great things done in those areas for Northeastern Wisconsin."
