**Senator Mark Miller Appointed to Joint Finance Committee**  
*Senator Honored to Serve*

(Madison)—Senator Mark Miller (D-Monona) was appointed today to Wisconsin’s Joint Committee on Finance. Praised by Senate Majority Leader Robson for his hard work and dedication, Senator Miller was selected as one of six Democrats to represent the Senate. This committee has primary responsibility for the 2007-09 State Biennial Budget.
