## **Group Established to Raise Awareness on Gaming Issues facing Wisconsin**

**Milwaukee, WI:** Several prominent organizations announced today the formation of a coalition group, Wisconsin Gaming for Wisconsin, in an effort to inform citizens of gaming issues affecting the state. Initial members of the coalition are the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Wisconsin, Milwaukee Urban League, VISIT Milwaukee and the Forest County Potawatomi Community.

“We think the hard-working men and women of Wisconsin should know how gaming issues could affect Wisconsin’s economy and businesses,” said Maria Monreal-Cameron President and CEO, Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Wisconsin.

The coalition’s first effort is an informational advertisement campaign focused on the Connecticut Mohegan Tribe’s efforts to develop the proposed Kenosha casino and the impact it could have on Wisconsin.

“This first effort is to educate the public about the potential for Wisconsin dollars flowing to Connecticut if the proposed Kenosha casino is built,” said Ralph Hollmon of the Milwaukee Urban League.

“The Potawatomi are pleased that these organizations have joined with us to help shed some light on these important issues,” said Jeff Crawford, Attorney General of the Forest County Potawatomi Community.

Wisconsin Gaming for Wisconsin was created to preserve and promote the tradition and integrity of gaming by Wisconsinites and to form relationships with community partners to support economic development that benefits all Wisconsin residents.
