**NEWS SUMMARY: Ex-Kenosha County Executive Agrees to Plead Guilty;
Prosecution to Recommend Two Years Imprisonment**

Former Kenosha County Executive Allan K. Kehl has agreed to plead guilty to a charge of conspiracy to receive improper payments, according to a plea agreement filed April 9, 2008. In the court document, Kehl admitted to wrongfully receiving \$15,000 in cash from businessman Dennis Troha – \$10,000 in 2005 while at Troha's office and \$5,000 in 2006 while the two stood in Troha's garage. In exchange for Kehl's plea of guilty, the United States Attorney has agreed to recommend a sentence of two years imprisonment. The maximum incarceration under the charge is five years. Kehl is the fourth person from the Kenosha area who has pled guilty or agreed to plead guilty in an FBI investigation of corrupt activity linked to an effort to establish an Indian casino in Kenosha.
