This matter having come before the Court, ex parte, with the Plaintiff requesting a temporary restraining order ordering the Defendant to stop playing, circulating, and/or purchasing or procuring the Defendant's radio advertisement which makes false representations about Mark Radcliffe, a candidate for office of Representative to the Assembly for the 92nd District of Wisconsin, the Court orders as follows:

The Court Finds and Orders as Follows:

1. That the plaintiff has filed with the Court a request for relief from false statements being made against him.

2. That it appears from a plain reading of the pleadings that the Plaintiff is entitled to relief from false representations that are intended to affect voting at an election as per Wisconsin Statute Sec. 12.05.

3. That only three days remain prior to the start of the November 4th, 2008 Wisconsin State election and said false statements are injurious to the Plaintiff.

4. That plaintiff has shown an ultimate probability of success that the defendant has violated Wisconsin Statute Sec. 12.05, and ~~that~~ that defendant has made false statements with actual malice regarding plaintiff.

5. That given the limited time prior to the election, the harm to Plaintiff is likely irreparable.

6. That no other adequate remedy at law exists at law.

7. That a temporary injunction is needed in order to preserve the status quo regarding the truth of statements regarding the Radcliffe for Assembly Committee.

8. That the defendant, ^{its} ~~their~~ officers, agents, representatives, ^{and} employees and ^{and} ~~assigns~~, are hereby enjoined from ^{causing to be} ~~playing, promoting, circulating, and/or purchasing or procuring~~ the radio advertisement that refers to Mark Radcliffe as supporting a plan to double taxes in Wisconsin, supporting a 15 billion dollar plan that creates new taxes, and/or refers to the Wall Street Journal as reporting that the plaintiff's plan represents a \$510.00 per month increase in taxes for every Wisconsin worker, or any other form of advertisement or communication that includes these false statements.

9. That this matter shall be set on for hearing on the imposition of a temporary injunction at 12:00 noon on Monday, November 3rd, 2008, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 813.025(2), in the main courtroom at the Jackson County Courthouse, 307 Main Street, Black River Falls, WI 54615.
