## **Sullivan Fund Raising Continues Momentum**

### ***Reynolds Actually LOSES Ground in Recent Campaign Finance Report***

Wauwatosa – Jim Sullivan, candidate for the 5<sup>th</sup> State Senate District, raised \$114,000 over the last eight months, marking the second finance reporting period in a row that Sullivan has out-raised Tom Reynolds. Sullivan surpassed the sitting senator by more than \$62,000 since January of 2006, and Reynolds actually has LESS cash on hand than he did in June. Sullivan increased his sizeable advantage over Reynolds to over \$20,000.

“Our campaign’s momentum has stayed strong throughout this whole year, and Tom Reynolds’ efforts have fallen flat over the past few months. With his extreme record, I’m not surprised that this community has left him behind,” said Sullivan. “We have out-raised him again and we are going to out-work him until November 7<sup>th</sup>.”

Recently, special interest groups have started running radio ads supporting Reynolds, attempting to prop up his fledgling campaign. “I’ve said it before and I’ll say it again: Tom Reynolds has a lot of friends in Madison that control a lot of special interest money, and I’m sure that we’ll be seeing their handiwork pretty soon,” said Sullivan. “However, I’ll be out going door-to-door delivering my message myself.”

The fact that Reynolds skipped a debate with Sullivan after agreeing to participate clearly played a role in his poor fundraising performance. “Tom Reynolds lost a lot of trust from this community when he broke his word and refused to go on record about the issues that affect people in the 5<sup>th</sup> Senate District every day. He’s trying to run from his extreme record and he’s having trouble finding people to support him,” said Sullivan.

“Our campaign has the support of the community, the funds to get our message out, and the volunteers to spread our voice throughout the district,” said Sullivan. “November 7<sup>th</sup> will be here soon enough and we will have the resources to win on Election Day.”
