Russ Darrow Continues Media Blitz

Commercial targets Russ Feingold's obsession with campaign finance reform.

WAUKESHA, WI – U.S. Senatorial candidate Russ Darrow continues his aggressive media campaign, releasing a new television ad that began running today. It's all a part of a strong advertising strategy designed to bring Russ Feingold's obsession with campaign finance reform to light before the Republican Party of Wisconsin's convention convenes next week.

The TV ad shows Feingold as he is, an out of touch, Washington insider who cares more about working on national issues, such as campaign finance reform, than he does about problems facing his own state.

"He seems to have found a national calling in Washington that's grabbed him and he just can't shake it," says Darrow. "This state has to come first. Not Washington, not the Washington Post, not the New York Times and not ambition or ego."

Darrow went on to say, "The numbers don't lie. Over the last three years alone he stood by and watched 78,900 manufacturing jobs leave Wisconsin."

The ad is second in a series of TV and radio commercials launched throughout the state, in addition to the release of "The Right Russ: The Movie", a nine minute movie mailed to tens of thousands of Wisconsin households.
