Property Tax Freeze on All Levels of Government

- Immediately upon taking the oath of office for Governor, Scott Walker will call the legislature into special session to pass a 2007 through 2010 property tax freeze.
- Scott Walker's freeze will require all taxing authorities in Wisconsin to limit the amount of tax levy to the 2006 amount for 2007, 2008, 2009, and 2010. This amount may be increased with only two exceptions: growth and vote.
- Referendum questions to increase the tax levy will only be allowed during regularly scheduled general elections in the fall and the spring.
- Bonding for operating budget funding will not be allowed.
- Require districts that levy tax be governed by elected bodies.
- Advocate for the passage of the Taxpayer Bill of Rights (TABOR).

Introduce a State Budget that Spends Less and Reduces the Structural Deficit

- Scott Walker's first state budget will reduce state spending.
- Additionally, Walker's budget will reduce the structural deficit and he will introduce a plan to eliminate the structural deficit by the end of his first term.

Integrity of Wisconsin's Ballot Box

- Jim Doyle and the Democrats have refused to protect the integrity of the ballot box in Wisconsin's electoral system. Scott Walker will not allow this to continue.
- Scott will work with the state legislature and pass a law that requires a State of Wisconsin issued Photo ID to vote.
- Scott will work with the state legislature to repeal "same-day" voter registration.
- Return absentee ballots to their original purpose - people who are absent on Election Day.
- Require that those who register voters be trained by local clerks or elections officials.

Tax Free Health Savings Accounts (HSA's) for Small Businesses and Farmers

- Scott Walker will call on the legislature to pass legislation similar to that vetoed by Jim Doyle earlier this year.

Maintain Two-Thirds Funding for Schools and Lift the Cap on School Choice Students

- Scott Walker will maintain the state's commitment to fund two-thirds of the cost of K-12 public education.
- The Walker administration will not allow government to dictate educational choices to parents concerned with their child's education. Scott Walker will lift the cap on school choice.

Protect Wisconsin jobs from Lawsuit Abuse

- Scott Walker will call on the legislature to deliver Medical Malpractice Limits and Liability Caps to his desk as quickly as possible. The Walker Administration will not allow trial lawyers to chase good Doctors and jobs out of Wisconsin.

Ethics Reform

- Scott Walker will prohibit any appointed employee from making monetary contributions to the Governor's campaign.
- Ban campaign contributions from any source until the budget has been passed and signed.
- Call on the leaders of both houses to institute a similar policy in the legislature.
