## **ENVIRONMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS TO HOLD EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS AHEAD OF GOVERNMENT HEARING**

- Who:** Representatives from the Sierra Club and Citizens for Responsible Power.
- What:** Citizens with questions or concerns can learn more about the issues surrounding the proposed power plant expansion in Oak Creek.
- Why:** Given recent developments, it is apparent that there remain some unanswered questions surrounding the environmental impact of this proposal and the permitting process so far. The Army Corps of Engineers can call for a full investigation into the environmental impact of the proposal, and citizens can ask them to do so at the September 29<sup>th</sup> public comment hearing they will hold at the Oak Creek Community Center from 7pm until 10pm. These information sessions will lay out all the issues so that citizens can provide informed comments to the Corps.
