VENUE

On 9/23/09, at approximately 18:29, I was conducting a traffic stop on a vehicle on Hwy 51 near milepost 189. At that time, I was also monitoring radio traffic from the Marathon County Sheriff's Department of a reckless driving complaint. The complaint had originated in Portage County. At this time, the reported reckless driver was now headed west on STH 29 near USH 51. The vehicle was reported as weaving all over the roadway and also had struck a curb. The vehicle was being followed by a witness who had called 911 to report the erratic driving. At this time, I released the driver from the traffic stop I was currently on. I then returned to my vehicle and stayed in position to wait for the reckless driver to pass my location. I obtained information from Marathon County Dispatch in reference to the suspect vehicle. They reported to me that the vehicle was a late 1990's model green Pontiac with a possible plate of 980-NLZ. They also advised that the reporting party that was following the suspect vehicle was in a silver Dodge Nitro. Marathon County Dispatch notified me that the suspect vehicle was north on USH 51 passing CTH N. I remained parked on the right shoulder of the road. Marathon County Dispatch then advised that the suspect vehicle had almost struck other vehicles as it was continuing north bound. I observed three vehicles in the center lane pass by me. The middle vehicle had no front plate and matched the description of the suspect vehicle. The vehicle behind it, a silver Dodge Nitro, honked its horn as it passed me. I activated my emergency lights and siren to pursue and stop the suspect vehicle. When I got behind the suspect vehicle it started to pull over to the right shoulder and then jerked back into the far right lane. The vehicle continued north about 300 feet and then pulled over onto the right shoulder and stopped. The traffic stop was conducted on STH 51 just north of CTH NN.

CONTACT WITH DRIVER

Sgt. Peterson of the Everest Metro Police Department arrived on scene about the time I was approaching the vehicle. I observed that the silver Dodge Nitro, had stopped about 200 feet in front of my location. I approached the subject's vehicle from the passenger side. I observed one male occupant who was in the driver's seat. I observed that the inside of the vehicle had lots of trash and other paper material on the floor boards and on the seats. I made contact with the driver and asked him to step out of the vehicle so I could speak with him. The driver exited his vehicle and stood behind his car. I explained to the driver the reason for the stop. I told him that we had received a report that his driving was erratic. I asked him if he had a reason for that and he stated he was trying to find a spot on the map. The subject appeared to be very sleepy. I asked him if he had taken any medications and he nodded his head no. I asked him if he had anything to drink and he again nodded his head no. I asked the subject for his driver's license and he

presented a Wisconsin photo driver's license to me. Sgt. Peterson informed me that the subject had a cell phone, map, M & M's, and a book on his front seat. The subject was identified as Jeffrey S. Wood m/w 9/12/69. I advised Mr. Wood to return to his vehicle. I checked the subject's information with my dispatch and they advised me that he had valid drivers license. I asked Mr. Wood to step out of the vehicle again. This was so I could perform field sobriety testing based on his erratic driving and his physical behavior. Mr. Wood complied and I instructed him to stand and face my vehicle. Mr. Wood was leaning against the rear of his vehicle while I was talking to him.

FIELD SOBRIETY TESTING

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS

I explained the instructions to Mr. Wood and he indicated he understood.

While the subject was standing with his heels and toes together I could observe that he was swaying side to side.

I explained the instructions to Mr. Wood and he indicated he knew what to do.

OBSERVATIONS:

The subject started the test before I could finish explaining the instructions. On his second, third, fourth step he missed heel to toe. On his fourth step he stepped off the line about 5 inches. When the subject turned around, he did not turn in the manner I had demonstrated to him. Instead he turned taking larger steps, turning out farther than needed. On his third and fourth step on the way back, he missed heel to toe and stepped off the line.

ONE LEG STAND

I explained the instructions to Mr. Wood and he indicated he knew what to do.

1. Subject sways while balancing
2. Uses arms for balance
3. Hops
4. Puts foot down

TOTAL CLUES: 4

OBSERVATIONS:

The subject began the test and between the count of one and two he began hopping to his right and was using his arms to balance. He put his foot down at the count of three. He then restarted the test. At the count of seven the subject began to hop again and put his foot down. He restarted the test and was swaying and using his arms to keep his balance. I stopped the test for his safety so that he would not fall down. Officer Peterson had then informed me that the subject had taken cold medicine.

PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST (PBT)

I conducted the PBT test and the result was .00. I asked the subject if he had taken any medicine besides his cold medicine. The subject said he did not. I asked the subject how much cold medicine he took and he stated he had about one shot of it.

ARREST AND SEARCH

I told the Mr. Wood he was under arrest for OWI. I placed handcuffs on the subject behind his back. I checked the handcuffs for fit and safety locked them. I searched the subject. In Wood's right pants pocket, was an orange prescription bottle. I asked the subject what he took the medication for and he stated it was for anxiety. I also located a small pocket knife in the subjects left pocket. Sgt. Peterson had asked the subject when he got the prescription filled. Sgt. Peterson said it was filled on 9/22/09 a day before. The original quantity of pills was 45. The bottle now only contained 7 pills. The medication was Lorazepam 0.5 mg prescribed by Dr. Peck. The prescription was filled at Walgreens located at 15 E. Main St. in Madison, WI. I told the subject I was concerned for his safety. I asked him where the other pills were. The subject had thought they dumped out in his car.

Mr. Wood was placed in the back seat of my squad car. I placed a seatbelt on the subject and secured the door.

VEHICLE SEARCH

I searched the immediate passenger area of the subject's vehicle with Sgt. Peterson. I was looking for evidence of the OWI arrest such as other medication that may have contributed to Wood's impairment. I looked inside the center console of the vehicle and I located a bottle of Top Care Nite-Time cold and flu relief. It was a bottle approximately half full of a green liquid that appeared to be a cough syrup. I placed the bottle of pills and the bottle of green liquid in an evidence bag so it was secure.

Tpr. Aures arrived on scene and obtained a written statement from the reporting party who called 911 about the reckless driver. That statement is attached. The vehicle was removed per Mr. Wood's request by a tow truck for safekeeping. Mt. View Towing was dispatched to remove the vehicle.

TRANSPORT TO HOSPITAL

I transported the subject for a blood draw to St. Claire's hospital without incident.

INFORMING THE ACCUSED

I read the subject the Informing the Accused form. He consented to a blood draw.

MEDICAL EVALUATION AND BLOOD DRAW

Mr. Wood was medically evaluated by the nurse and ER Doctor at the hospital. They deemed that he needed to stay at the hospital for approximately five hours due to his medical condition. Shana Slack from the hospital staff conducted the blood draw without incident. I observed her collect and seal the blood kit.

ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT

I read Mr. Wood his rights and he agreed to answer questions. That report is attached. I also determined from Mr. Wood that he had taken six Lorazepam pills during the day. The prescribed dose according to the prescription bottle is three tablets daily. The subject also stated he took two doses of the Nite-Time cough syrup at about 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM. The cough syrup contained Acetaminophen which is a pain reliever, Dextromethorphan which is a cough suppressant, and Doxylamine succinate which is an antihistamine. I also learned from the subject he was a State of Wisconsin Assembly Representative.

The subject remained under the Hospital's care until he was medically released. I was informed from Tracy at St. Claire's Hospital at about 10:40 PM that Mr. Wood was discharged and released to his father in-law.

MISC

The evidence was packaged and turned into the State Patrol Headquarters evidence room. Attached is also a witness statement from Jill Sann who was the reporting party.

SP4197 8/2004 s.343.305(4) Wis. Stats.

Wisconsin Department of Transportation

Under Wisconsin's Implied Consent Law, I am required to read this notice to you:

You have either been arrested for an offense that involves driving or operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or both, or you are suspected of driving or being on duty time with respect to a commercial motor vehicle after consuming an intoxicating beverage.

This law enforcement agency now wants to test one or more samples of your breath, blood or urine to determine the concentration of alcohol or drugs in your system. If any test shows more alcohol in your system than the law permits while driving, your operating privilege will be suspended. If you refuse to take any test that this agency requests, your operating privilege will be revoked and you will be subject to other penalties. The test results or the fact that you refused testing can be used against you in court.

If you take all the requested tests, you may choose to take further tests. You may take the alternative test that this law enforcement agency provides free of charge. You also may have a test conducted by a qualified person of your choice at your expense. You, however, will have to make your own arrangements for that test.

If you have a commercial driver license or were operating a commercial motor vehicle, other consequences may result from positive test results or from refusing testing, such as being placed out of service or disqualified.

In addition, under 2003 Wisconsin Act 97, your operating privileges will also be suspended if a detectable amount of a restricted controlled substance is in your blood.
