

Write-in Candidate

We have been notified that Senator Hillary Clinton will be a Presidential Preference Vote write-in candidate. We request that your county board of canvassers report to the Elections Board the number of votes cast for this candidate.

- On your official canvass, report the votes for this write-in candidate in the scattering votes along with all other write-in votes.
- On a separate report, list
 - ✓ the number of votes cast for Senator Clinton
 - ✓ the reporting units in which they were cast
 - ✓ and the party in which they were cast

This way interested individuals will be able to obtain this information from us.

Canvass Delivery and Deadlines

Please note that your primary canvass tabular statement is to be send electronically to wired@seb.state.wi.us as soon as possible after you complete your canvass. Your original canvass, including the summary and signed certification by the Board of Canvassers must be delivered to the State Elections Board **no later than February 24, 2004**. Because of the short period of time allowed for canvassing, it is essential that we receive your canvasses as soon as possible.

Spring election canvasses are to be delivered **no later than April 16, 2004**.
