This communication is to inform you that the verified complaint you filed against John Humphries and Lowell Holtz with the Wisconsin Elections Commission ("Commission") was dismissed by the Commission at its March 14, 2017.

The Commission unanimously passed the following motion:

The Commission dismisses the complaint filed by Scot Ross and One Wisconsin Now on the basis that the allegations and documents contained in the complaint do not violate the election bribery provisions contained in Wis. Stat. § 12.11, therefore there can be no reasonable suspicion that a violation of this law has occurred. The Commission also directs staff to send the complainant and respondents in this matter a closure letter, informing them of the Commission's dismissal of the complaint.
