Madison, Wisconsin – Today, Dane County elected officials announced their support for Judge Rebecca Dallet in her campaign for Wisconsin Supreme Court.

She has served as the presiding judge in domestic violence and misdemeanor court, and presided over serious felony, homicide and drug courts, as well as civil court.

With the support of local leaders, elected officials, and judges from across the state, Judge Dallet plans to bring her vision of restoring the independence of the Supreme Court that interprets and upholds the law in a fair and balanced way.
