MADISON – Governor Scott Walker released the following statement regarding the White House's nomination of Milwaukee attorney Gordon Giampietro to serve on the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin.

“Gordon’s civil and criminal trial work for more than 20 years in the same court he has been nominated to serve, both in private practice and as an Assistant U.S. Attorney, will make him a valuable asset to the Eastern District,” Governor Walker said. “Notably, he also served for three years as a law clerk for the Honorable Rudolph T. Randa. I am confident, like Judge Randa, Gordon will serve our country and Wisconsin with humility, honor, and distinction as a member of the Eastern District bench.
