These cuts, if approved, will mark the elimination of over 300 front line fire fighters from YOUR Fire Department since he took office 14 years ago.

Joining us in this opposition for the protection and safety of the citizens we care so deeply about will be over 200 Fire Fighters from around the State of Wisconsin to voice their concerns for the safety and well being of the constituency of Milwaukee.
