Milwaukee Public Schools elementary and middle school students will present a special program that celebrates the cultures and identifies the challenges facing countries around the world during a special fair on **Monday, March 20**. The schools – whose students speak 35 different languages – have been working all year on their projects. This work is part of a new district initiative: the United Nations Schools of International Learning program.

The program is sponsored through a \$100,000 grant from the Greater Milwaukee Foundation's Annette J. Roberts & Joan R. Robertson Fund for World Peace, World Law and Peace Education.
