

NRSC: Sen. Baldwin doubles down on blocking Judge Gorsuch

It took weeks of being pressured but Tammy Baldwin finally agreed to meet with President Trump's Supreme Court nominee Judge Gorsuch last night. Despite finding him "very smart" Tammy doubled down on her decision to [block Judge Gorsuch's nomination](#):
