**BROOKFIELD, WI.** —Tom Palzewicz, a successful small business owner and U.S. Navy veteran, announced today he is launching a campaign for the U.S. House of Representatives from Wisconsin's 5th District.

"My campaign is going to be about helping more people achieve the American Dream," said Palzewicz. "Whether it was tracking subs across the ocean, helping Wisconsin banks navigate Wall Street, or running my own business, I have learned that leadership is about service. I'm ready to serve."
