Washington, D.C. - Tuesday, State Representative John Nygren (R-Marinette) received the “Dr. Nathan Davis Award for Outstanding Government Service” from the American Medical Association (AMA). Rep. Nygren received the award in recognition of his work sponsoring legislation to fight the growing opioid and heroin epidemic in Wisconsin. Rep. Nygren released the following statement regarding the award:
