[Madison, WI]— With thousands of Wisconsinites traveling to the Wisconsin State Fair, the Republican Party of Wisconsin is launching a billboard in downtown Milwaukee to highlight Senator Baldwin for her defense of the Washington status quo over hard-working Wisconsin veterans and families—specifically those she failed at the Tomah VA.
