Madison, Wisconsin – On Thursday, State Senator Alberta Darling (R-River Hills) and State Representative John Nygren (R-Marinette), the Co-Chairs of the budget-writing Joint Finance Committee, released the following statement regarding savings in the Medicaid budget projected by the Department of Health Services:

“We are pleased with the efforts by the Department of Health Services to save \$325 million. This is the third straight year we won’t have to pass a budget repair bill to cover a deficit in the Medicaid budget.

While having a surplus this large in Medicaid is rare, it’s a testament to responsible and careful budgeting. Wisconsin was able to cover everyone living in poverty without taking the Obamacare expansion. Once again, our state is leading in reforms.
