In recognition of Manufacturing Month, the event will focus on the manufacturing industry. As of October 3, there were 18 employers registered, offering over 260 job openings.

For better chances of success, those attending are urged to research employers prior to the event, prepare yourself for your introduction when meeting the potential employer, and to dress appropriately, along with bringing your resume and completing applications online prior to the event.
