WASHINGTON—House Speaker Paul Ryan (R-WI) issued the following statement after meeting with Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau:

"I appreciated the opportunity to welcome Prime Minister Trudeau to the Capitol this afternoon. We had a productive discussion focused on ways to deepen ties between the U.S. and Canada with respect to trade and national security.
