

U.S. Sen. Baldwin: Tammy Baldwin for Senate breaks Wisconsin fundraising record for quarter and year

MADISON — Tammy Baldwin for Senate announced the campaign broke multiple records for funds raised by a statewide candidate in an off-year.

Tammy Baldwin for Senate raised more than \$2.5 million for the second quarter of the off-year, a record among all statewide campaigns in Wisconsin. The campaign broke a state record by raising \$4.7 million in the first six months of an off-year. Tammy Baldwin for Senate also has more than \$3.9 million in the bank, which is \$1 million more than either Senator Johnson or Russ Feingold had at this point in 2015. “As top tier contenders continue to pass on running against her, Tammy is in a strong position heading into 2018 to continue to stand up to the special interests in Washington that support the status quo.”
