

Waukesha County: County Highway E (Main St) in North Prairie: Brief closure of one block segment starts Sunday

(WAUKESHA, WI) – A one-block segment of County Trunk Highway E (Main St.) in North Prairie is to close Sunday October 22 at 4 a.m. for reconstruction of the railroad crossing located south of E Sadd St. ([map](#))

The closure occurs only at the railroad crossing. Through-traffic will follow the posted detour route ([map](#)) via CTH ZZ to STH 59, while access to local residences and businesses will be maintained. The closure is scheduled to conclude late Friday October 27.
