Dogs must be people and animal friendly. Admission is \$5.00 per person (children 7 and under are free) and \$15.00 per family (up to 2 adults and three children under the age of 18). Tickets may be purchased online in advance or the day of at Barks for Parks!

Dane County Parks was one of the first park systems in the nation to develop off-leash dog exercise areas and is recognized as a national leader. Off-leash areas are available at all seven Dane County Dog Parks, including Badger Prairie, Capital Springs Recreation Area, Indian Lake, Prairie Moraine, Token Creek, Viking, and Yahara Heights County Parks.
