Madison, WI – Today the Wisconsin Legislative Audit Bureau (LAB) released its third biennial audit of the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC), the state's lead economic development organization. The audit highlighted a range of WEDC's improvements, including its oversight and administration of various programs that facilitate the advancement of Wisconsin's economy.
