Madison, Wisconsin – The Milwaukee Journal Sentinel [today reported](#) that out-of-state billionaire puppet and GOP Senate candidate Kevin Nicholson last week offered tough criticism of Speaker of the House Paul Ryan of Janesville, WI, for failing to adequately represent his constituents in Congress and [having a “light footprint in the state”](#) of Wisconsin.
