GOP tax plans are a massive transfer of wealth to billionaires, corporations, and Wall Street, but leave millions of middle-class families paying more

GOP tax plans are funded by gutting Medicare and Medicaid

MADISON — Right-wing state Senator Leah Vukmir and out-of-state billionaire puppet Kevin Nicholson [have officially endorsed](#) U.S. House and Senate Republicans' efforts to gift massive tax cuts to corporations and billionaires — cuts paid for by raising taxes on middle-income families and gutting Medicare and Medicaid.

Here's a look at the Republican plans that Vukmir and Nicholson endorsed:

- Millions of middle-class families would pay more in taxes under [both plans](#).
- Both plans slash tax rates for corporations.
- Eliminating the SALT deduction, as the Senate GOP does, [would hike taxes on 31%](#) of

Wisconsin taxpayers.

- Neither GOP tax plan closes the carried interest loophole — a loophole that Wall Street bankers exploit to avoid paying their fair share in taxes.
- The GOP tax plans are [paid for by gutting Medicare and Medicaid](#).
