[Madison, WI]— In a desperate attempt to defend the Washington status quo, Senator Baldwin engaged in historic partisan obstruction yesterday in a failed attempt to block President Trump's Nominee for Supreme Court Justice, Judge Neil Gorsuch, from the bench.
