*Republicans are charging that Democrats might accomplish more than even some liberals hope: Stopping Wisconsin's \$3 billion factory deal with Foxconn Technology Group.*

*The Democratic candidates for governor have vowed to try to block or renegotiate the incentives to the Taiwanese company, which are aimed at bringing a flat-screen display plant and thousands of jobs to Racine County.*

*"Democrats are so desperate to score a few cheap political points that they are willing to put hard-working families at risk by creating a chilling effect on investment and job creation," Sen. Dan Feyen (R-Fond du Lac) and Rep. Adam Neylon (R-Pewaukee) said in a joint statement Tuesday.*
