Ron Kind's short-lived consideration to seek his party's nomination for governor has come to an end, at a time when his own support in the 3rd District is in question. Republican Party of Wisconsin Executive Director Mark Morgan released the following statement on Congressman Kind, who faces re-election in a district that is newly targeted by the National Republican Congressional Committee after President Donald Trump carried it in 2016:
