

# AG Schimel edges Dem rival Kaul in fundraising over second half of 2017

AG Brad Schimel just edged Dem rival Josh Kaul in fundraising over the second half of 2017, but had nearly \$250,000 more in the bank to end the year.

Schimel raised \$271,775 between July 1 and Dec. 31, spent \$123,706 and finished with \$529,258 cash on hand.

For the full year, Schimel raised \$568,810, according to a cover sheet provided to WisPolitics.com by the state GOP.

Kaul's campaign says the Madison attorney raised more than \$255,000 in the last half of 2017, putting him at just over \$429,000 raised since he got into the race in April.

The campaign said Kaul will report more than \$280,000 in cash on hand.
