

Club for Growth: Supreme Court nomination will be a key issue in Wisconsin Senate race says Club for Growth President David McIntosh

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Washington, DC – Justice Kennedy’s decision to retire puts in play a key issue in November’s Senate election, one that could be decisive for Sen.
