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Walker Still Hasn't Delivered Promises on Jobs and Schools

Today, the DGA released a [video](#) ahead of Wisconsin Gov. Scott Walker's State of the State address. The video, titled "Broken Promises," highlights some of Walker's worst broken promises.

When Walker first ran for governor, he promised to create 250,000 jobs in just four years. In 2014, Politifact [rated](#) promise as officially broken. And in the three years since then, Walker has still [fallen short](#) of 250,000.

Walker also ran ads claiming that Wisconsin was making record investments in the public education system. Politifact [rated](#) that claim mostly false.
