Madison, WI – Democratic State Treasurer candidate, Sarah Godlewski, today launched her first TV ad ahead of the August 14th primary election and is among the first of the statewide candidates to hit the airwaves. The upbeat ad highlights Godlewski's work for the Department of Defense saving taxpayers tens of millions of dollars and her experience as a finance expert and small business owner.

As the leader of the Save Our Fiscal Watchdog committee this spring, Godlewski shined a light on the Treasurer's office, and as a candidate for the position, she is raising its profile across the state.
