MADISON — On Tuesday, former federal prosecutor and candidate for Attorney General Josh Kaul will join former La Crosse County District Attorney Roger LeGrand and La Crosse community members for the next Justice Tour stop.

As Wisconsin's Attorney General, Josh Kaul will work to make Wisconsin safer and stronger than we're on track for right now. He will respond to Wisconsin's opioid and meth epidemic like the crisis it is: going after large-scale drug traffickers, supporting increased access to substance-abuse treatment, and holding pharmaceutical companies accountable for their role in the opioid epidemic. Josh will also work to address increased testing delays at the state crime labs and to make sure Wisconsin never sees a backlog of untested rape kits again. And as AG, Josh will be an advocate for community policing and prosecution.
