Grafton - The White House announced today that the United States would effectively pull out of the Joint Comprehensive Plan Of Action (JCPOA), an agreement between China, France, Germany, Russia, the United Kingdom, the United States, the European Union and Iran that prohibited Iran from developing nuclear weapons. By refusing to waive the imposition of sanctions, President Trump has done harm to American diplomacy and American interests.
