Franklin, WI—Patti Logsdon has taken the lead in the race for Milwaukee County's 9th Supervisory District, picking up another high-profile endorsement.

Republican Wisconsin Senator Alberta Darling has endorsed Patti Logsdon and asks the voters of Franklin, Oak Creek, and Hales Corners to stand with Patti on election day. Darling joins Senator Leah Vukmir, U.S. Senate Candidate Kevin Nicholson, State Representative Janel Brandtjen, Milwaukee County Supervisor Dan Sebring, and Milwaukee County Supervisor Deanna Alexander in backing Patti Logsdon for County Board.
