**Alderman Khalif J. Rainey** encourages interested residents to apply for a field representative position within the United States Census Bureau. Starting salaries range from **\$14.89 to \$19.32 per hour**. Employees will get a night differential and be reimbursed on gas. The hours are flexible based on the survey.

Alderman Rainey says this is a **great opportunity to make money** and be part of a process that has many **benefits to the community**.

“The data is not only used by the federal government to determine where to spend on low-income programs like food assistance or Medicare, but also by health officials to learn where to target their intervention-based resources,” he said, noting businesses also use the data to determine where to expand operations such as adding distribution centers.
