Members ratify new press club board of governors

MILWAUKEE, WI – September 19, 2018 – The Milwaukee Press Club is pleased to announce that **Gene Mueller**, host of Wisconsin's Morning News for 620 WTMJ Radio has been appointed president and will serve in that role for the next year. Mueller was appointed effective with the membership's ratification of annual elections to the club's board of governors at its Annual Meeting September 18th.

Mueller is an entertaining fixture in the Milwaukee radio market, having spent the last 25 years as morning show co-host on WKTI-FM, WTMJ's former sister station. A native of Sheboygan, he started his radio career at Sheboygan North High School, attended the University of Wisconsin- Stevens Point and began his professional radio career at WSPT AM/FM.
