Janesville, WI - Cathy Myers, a Janesville School Board Member and Democrat running for Congress in Wisconsin's 1st District, announced that her campaign has reached the \$1 million fundraising milestone less than a year into her campaign to represent Wisconsin's 1st District in Congress.
