Today it was confirmed a suspicious packaged mailed to Tom Steyer was intercepted at a mail facility in Burlingame, CA. In response, Tom Steyer issued the following statement:

We're thankful that everyone we work with at NextGen America and Need to Impeach is safe — that's always our first priority, and will continue to be our first priority.

We are seeing a systematic attack on our democracy and our rule of law that extends much further than just one isolated terrorist in Florida. Whether it's voter suppression, voter intimidation, attacks on our free press, gerrymandering, or attempted violence — the trust and norms that are the actual basis for our civil society and political system are being eroded.
