MADISON, WI – The NFIB Wisconsin political action committee, NFIB WI PAC, announced today it has endorsed Governor Scott Walker in his bid for reelection. The endorsement comes after a poll of small-business members in the state, a vote of approval from NFIB's state PAC Board and its Leadership Council. NFIB's National Board, made up of small-business owners from around the country, has also given Scott Walker's endorsement a thumbs up.

"Gov. Scott Walker has a record of solid leadership that demonstrates time and again that he cares about small businesses and he knows how important their success is to the state's economy," **said Bill G. Smith, state director of NFIB in Wisconsin.** "He succeeded in lowering taxes, fees, and reducing the burden of regulations on small businesses during his tenure as governor."
