*Proposals would strengthen and protect public education system*

Brookfield, WI — Tom Palzewicz, candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives in Wisconsin's 5th district, today announced a comprehensive plan to strengthen and protect public education for all, ensuring American competitiveness for the next century.

“Education is arguably the most important public service our government provides, yet too many schools are in a state of crisis,” said Palzewicz, a Navy veteran and small-business owner making his first run for public office. “The Trump Administration is waging war on our public schools instead of investing in our public education system.
