Palzewicz calls on legislator to pass legislation and reunite families

Brookfield, WI — Tom Palzewicz, candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives in Wisconsin's 5th district, today sent the following letter to Jim Sensenbrenner this morning:

Rep. Sensenbrenner,

I am appalled by the current administration's recent policy change that forces families apart. These families are often fleeing danger and looking for a better life in our country, just like your ancestors, and just like mine.
