MADISON – State Representative Jimmy Anderson released the following statement in response to Governor Walker’s attempt to deny the people of the 1st Senate District and the 42nd Assembly District the right to have an election.

“Wisconsin Republicans are arguing that holding special elections in vacant legislative seats would be ‘a waste of money’.
