

Rep. Kitchens: State Building Commission approves Peninsula State Park infrastructure project

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MADISON - State Representative Joel Kitchens (R-Sturgeon Bay) released the following statement after the State Building Commission voted earlier today to approve funding for infrastructure improvements at Peninsula State Park:
