Clinton, WI—State Representative Amy Loudenbeck (R-Clinton) released the following statement regarding her firm commitment to seek re-election for Wisconsin's 31st Assembly District, which includes eastern Rock and western Walworth counties.

"I am humbled by the words of encouragement and support I have received over the past two days regarding my viability as a candidate for the opening in the 1st Congressional District. After thoughtful consideration, I feel my constituents will be best served by my re-election to the 31st District in the Wisconsin State Assembly. "I love serving the 31st Assembly District and I feel like I am making a difference for my constituents and the citizens of Wisconsin.
