WASHINGTON (October 19, 2018) – The Republican State Leadership Committee (RSLC) is continuing its issue ad campaign highlighting Caleb Frostman's desire to increase taxes and fees, and even implement tolling, while openly and publicly supporting a single-payer healthcare system in Wisconsin and the billions it would cost taxpayers in Senate District 1 and across the Badger State.
